

CHAMPAGNE LOMBARDI – STÉPHANE LOMBARDI

Champagne – Côtes de Bar

As owner-grower, STÉPHANE LOMBARDI himself takes care of the selection of the grapes and supervises the process of making champagne until bottling. Guardian of the tradition, he practices a responsible culture, avoiding the treatments and using the natural elements. At 150-180 metres above sea level, the rolling hillsides formerly known as “Les Côtes à Bras” offer ideal sun exposition. Mostly limestone (chalky marl and limestone) and clay, which promotes drainage and gives champagne its very particular minerality.

SONS OF WINE – Farid Yahimi

Alsace - Ammerschwihr

By traveling through France, meeting like-minded people, exchanging and sharing ideas, Farid Yahimi became one of the co-Founders of the “Association des Vins Naturels”, established in 2005.

“I had this dream of making natural wine. With the guidance of my friend Christian Binner, through his confidence in us and a few final, successful tests in my garage, I am going to start making wine on his premises this year.”

Farid buys only 100% organic and biodynamic grapes. All his wines have zero sulphur. “I try to make an honest wine and as I am the first natural wine negotiant in France, I have pretty much free rein. Without constraint or preconceived ideas, I make wine out of whatever mother earth will give me.”

MARC DELIENNE

Beaujolais - Fleurie + Brouilly + St Amour

After quitting his tech job in Paris, Marc Delienne packed up and studied at Domaine de Trevallon with Eloi Durbach, before purchasing Chateau de l'Abbaye, in the heart of Fleurie on 2015. Domaine Marc Delienne aims to translate the character of his sandy, loamy soils into each of his Beaujolais wines. This is aided by the biodynamic philosophies he uses to encourage biodiversity among his 40-80-year-old vines. In the winery, whole clusters go into concrete vats, relying on native yeasts to begin fermentation. They pump over minimally to restrain the levels of extraction, and with no fining or filtration, and very little sulphur added, they keep things as stripped back as possible in order to achieve aromatic, textured and powerful expressions of the Fleurie terroir.

BÉNÉDICTE & STÉPHANE TISSOT

Jura – Côtes du Jura & Arbois

André and Mireille, Stéphane's parents, started the Domaine in 1962. The Domaine was certified organic in 1999 and biodynamic in 2004 and new plantings were all done with massale selection rather than the clones then used throughout the region.

Stéphane produced his first "Chardonnay de Terroir" in 1997 and in 2000 he was able to purchase great parcels in Les Bruyeres, La Mailloche and Chateau Chalon. "Their biodynamic work in the vineyards gives pleasure and enables to vinify wines in a natural way that reflects the terroirs and their work, far from the industrial techniques that banalize wine." Stéphane's energy, intelligence and hard work have helped transform the Jura from a vinous backwater into one of the world's most exciting wine regions.

LE CLOS DU CAILLOU

Côtes du Rhône, Châteauneuf du Pape – Courthézon

The current owner, Sylvie Vacheron's father, Claude Pouizin, started to deforest the hunting reserve. He saw the potential of this terroir that he thought was exceptional and he decided to plant vines instead of the wood. On sandy and rolled pebbled soil now sit 9ha of Châteauneuf du Pape and 45ha Côtes du Rhône. The domain obtained its organic certification with the 2010 vintage, although the efforts towards natural practices were started by Claude Pouizin in the early 1950's. Building on this philosophy, a part of the vineyard is worked following biodynamic practices and the goal is to convert all the vineyards to biodynamic principles.

CLOS DES MOURRES – Naïs, Ingrid & Jean-Philippe Bouchet


Côtes du Rhône – Cairanne

Clos des Mourres, led by the husband-and-wife team of Jean-Philippe and Ingrid Bouchet, is a beacon of natural winemaking in the Southern Rhône. Their story is one of a deep connection to the land, which they've cultivated organically from the start and with a touch of biodynamics.

Their winemaking philosophy is all about minimal intervention. Grapes are hand-harvested, fermentation happens with natural yeasts, and they use little to no added sulfites. The wines are often unfined and unfiltered, preserving their authentic character.

Their name, "Clos des Mourres," is a charming tribute to a wild salad that grows in their vineyards, symbolizing their commitment to a biodiverse and natural environment. This philosophy extends to the cellar, where they age their wines in unique vessels like egg-shaped ceramics, believing these vessels "energize" the wine. The result is a portfolio of incredibly vibrant, honest, and drinkable wines that truly capture the spirit of their terroir in Cairanne and Vaison-la-Romaine.

DOMAINE GRAMENON - Michèle Aubéry & Maxime-François Laurent

Côtes du Rhône

The story begins in 1978 when Michèle Aubéry-Laurent and her husband, Philippe Laurent, purchased a barn and 12 hectares of old vines in Montbrison-sur-Lez, in the Drôme Provençale. They were pioneers of organic farming in the area, committed to cultivating their vines without the use of chemical fertilizers or pesticides from the very beginning. Their first vintage was in 1979, and their initial cuvée, "Ceps Centenaires," quickly earned a reputation for its quality.

Following Philippe's unexpected passing in 1999, Michèle led the estate alone with a steadfast commitment to natural winemaking, a legacy her son Maxime-François now carries on. They are particularly renowned for their Grenache-based wines, with some cuvées coming from century-old vines that give a unique sense of place and character.

Their history is one of resilience and a steadfast dedication to producing vibrant, pure, and "living" wines that have earned them a cult following among natural wine enthusiasts worldwide.

LA FERME SAINT-MARTIN - Thomas Jullien

Côtes du Rhône – Ventoux, Beaumes de Venise

La Ferme Saint Martin, a family-run estate in the heart of the Rhône Valley, is led by the father-and-son team of Guy and Thomas Jullien. Their winemaking philosophy is deeply rooted in a respect for the land and a non-interventionist approach, resulting in wines that are a pure and authentic expression of their high-altitude terroir.

The vineyards are situated in the charming village of Suzette, perched at the top of the Beaumes-de-Venise appellation. The vines are grown on terraces at altitudes ranging from 450 to 600 meters, which contributes to a unique microclimate and fresher, more elegant wines than those typically found in the warmer parts of the Southern Rhône. The soils are a blend of limestone, clay, and gray marl, which impart a distinct minerality to the wines.

The Julliens also cultivate a diverse range of grape varieties, including Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault, and Roussanne, some of which are very old vines. They have also experimented with late-ripening varieties like Counoise and Terret Noir to adapt to a changing climate, which helps them maintain acidity and freshness.

LA ROCHE BUISSIÈRE - Antoine & Laurence Joly

Côtes du Rhône – Cairanne

Domaine La Roche Buissièvre is a family-owned estate in the Southern Rhône, led by Antoine and Laurence Joly, and celebrated for its commitment to natural winemaking. The domaine is situated in a cooler, high-altitude village of Cairanne, which helps them produce wines with a distinctive freshness and elegance.

The Joly family has been farming organically since the 1980s, long before it became a trend, earning official certification in 1990. They see the vineyard as a living ecosystem, and their practices focus on promoting biodiversity and soil health.

In the cellar, their approach is equally non-interventionist, using indigenous yeasts and minimal to no added sulfites. The resulting wines, often bottled unfined and unfiltered, are a vibrant and authentic reflection of their terroir.

Domaine de Panisse has a long history in the Southern Rhone Valley dating back almost 600 years. In 1492, the Domaine was the property of the Lord Dominique of Panisse, which as you can see, is where the Domaine took its name from. Tucked in a typical Provencal 15th-century building surrounded by 16 acres of Chateauneuf du Pape vines. In April 2020, Vacheron family who owns Clos du Caillou bought over the vineyard and it is now run by Axel Vacheron, Marilou Vacheron and Antoine Robert.




DOMAINE DE CASSAGNAU – Dr Jacques Abet

Languedoc – Aude

Family-owned since the eighteenth century, the estate owes its longevity to its women. Dr Jacques Abet's grandmother Berthe, who managed the estate for six decades, took it through two world wars and many viticultural crises. He inherited this family property from his mother, Jacqueline. You'll find Jacques in the tiny village of Pauligne near Limoux, at the heart of "Cathar country". For the past few years, thanks to passionate dedication, strict standards and an authentic approach, he has been breathing new life into the estate. Whenever the vines need him, he swaps his doctor's coat for winegrower's gear, driving the tractor, pruning or working in the winery with his oenologist. The scientist in him gives way to the farmer, repeating the same gestures as his ancestors before him. An enthusiastic head of a magnificent estate, this bon vivant has succeeded in reconciling his two activities of GP and winemaker.

DOMAINE BEGUDE – James & Catherine Kingslake

Languedoc – Aude

Domaine Begude is 24 hectares of excellent Limousine terroir, cultivated for more than 3 centuries. A site admirably nestled at an altitude of 300m up on the foothill of Pyrenees near Limoux. The Domaine was purchased in 2003 by British couple James and Catherine Kinglake. The Kingslakes have converted the vineyard over to organic farming, using only natural fertilizers and no irrigation. Certified organic since 2012.

MAXIME MAGNON

Languedoc – Corbières

The fact that Maxime Magnon has been at the forefront of one of the most revolutionary wine movements in France should give him a justifiable swagger. But the thirty-something Burgundian is a reluctant hero. He was not born into a Domaine, so he chose to make his wines not in Burgundy, but in the Corbières. He was fortunate to have purchased some prime parcels of old vines from abandoned plots and he still rents his cellar, making him a true *Garagiste*.

He farms nine parcels over eleven hectares, with steep vineyards that reach high altitudes, and manages it all on his own. Maxime is part of the new wave of passionate viticulturists who cultivate their vines with the utmost respect for nature and the soil. He's certified organic, but also incorporates biodynamic practices into his vineyard management.

JEAN-BAPTISTE SENAT

Languedoc - Minervois

As the years go by, the style of Senat wines has evolved. Using exclusively grape varieties with a strong Mediterranean identity, and putting Grenache at the centre of winemaking, each vintage has found its style, but the writing is global and goes in a unique direction, that of drinkability. Little interventionist, Jean-Baptiste likes wines without artifice. He often compares them to a woman with too much makeup, preferring the naturalness of a less superfluous beauty. The constant search for maturity and freshness requires precision and a high concentration during the grape harvest.

CHÂTEAU de ROQUEFORT

Provence - Côtes de Provence & Bouche de Rhône

The Château de Roquefort is ideally situated in The Côtes de Provence Appellation, where their 25 hectares of organic vineyards are cultivated biodynamically at an altitude of 390 metres, cut out of the imposing rocky clay-limestone soils. The vineyards have been certified bio since 2006. It is in this naturally wild environment that Raimond de Villeneuve has chosen to follow his passion; the life of a vigneron, for over 25 years. The terroir here is essential thanks to the microclimate created by altitude and the fact that the vineyards are facing North-Northwest, which brings much freshness to his wines. By their choice of culture, Raimond and his faithful vineyard manager, José, maintain with precision the balance and respect of nature, all the way from the grafting of the vines, through to the harvest. Today nearly 40% of the vines have been grafted on the vine, with carefully selected grafts.

Historically, the region around Marmande has been more famous for tomatoes than for wine. Elian da Ros might change all that. After working for five years with Domaine Zind-Humbrecht in Alsace, he returned to Cокумент in 1998, constructed a simple winery and took the daring step of being the first winemaker to produce and bottle his own wine under the Cotes-du-Marmandais appellation. The wines are a tour-de-force of delicious drinkability. From Le Vin est une Fête (Wine is a Party) to the single-vineyard Clos Baquey, there's a time and a place to enjoy everything that comes from this cellar.





DOMAINE DU PECH – Magali Tissot & Ludovic Bonnelle

SouthWest – Buzet

Domaine du Pech is situated on the slopes of Sainte-Colombe-en-Bruilhois in the extreme south east of the appellation. The white gravels have excellent drainage and the consequent reflection of light and accumulation of heat ensures optimal maturity for the grapes. Viticulture is “biodynamic”. No fertilizers have been used for twenty years. Since 2000 yields have been significantly reduced and since 2004 the drive towards biodynamic methods of cultivation has included the use of medicinal plants as well as minerals, thereby necessitating minimal treatments with copper or use of sulphur. Only natural yeasts and bacteria are used and the wines are bottled without filtration. Daniel Tissot, son of long-standing winemaking family in Jura, has been making wine and winning medals in the Côtes de Buzet since 1980. In 1997 the estate was taken over by his daughter Magali and her partner Ludovic.

South West – Côtes de Gascogne, Madiran

The Brumont wines benefit now from an international recognition and remain at a very good value for money. Alain Brumont took over the little family wine estate, Château Bouscassé, in 1979, then purchased Château Montus to create the wine of his dreams, "his" wine. Inventive, a tireless builder, and possessing a good bit of sheer nerve, he had constructed his first underground cellars at Bouscassé in 1988, then the new Château Montus cellars in 1995.

DOMAINE BRETON – Catherine & Pierre Breton



Loire Valley – Vouvray + Bourgueil + Chinon

Catherine & Pierre Breton are the real life bon vivants vignerons of lore. They are passionate about what they do, they enjoy sharing it with others, and they entertain with generosity and charm. That they make great wine with such integrity makes our appreciation of them complete.

The Bretons farm eleven hectares of vines just east of Bourgueil in the village of Restigné. They produce Chinon and Bourgueil, as well as a bit of Vouvray, creating honest wines for both early consumption and longer aging.

The Bretons first introduced biodynamic practices into their viticulture in 1994, just after receiving their organic certification in 1991. In fact, they have become international icons for the natural wine movement in an area where the climate and soil can make organic viticulture difficult.

DOMAINE PELLÉ

Loire Valley – Menetou-Salon, Morogues & Sancerre

Domaine Pellé is a fourth-generation estate run by the talented and hard-working Paul-Henry Pellé. The winery was officially started in the 1950's. Paul-Henry's grandfather, in fact, played an instrumental role in establishment of the Appellation, and lobbied hard for it to be called Menetou-Salon rather than the Coteaux Sancerrois that had been proposed at the time. The majority of the estate's 40 ha of vines are situated in and around the village of Morogues. As Paul-Henry explained, Morogues is comprised of 90% Kimmeridgean limestone, it helps to create complex, elegant, mineral-laden wines that can age well too. The property is planted to 1/3 Pinot Noir and 2/3 Sauvignon Blanc, including 5 ha of vines outside of Menetou.

DOMAINE DES ROCHES NEUVES – THIERRY GERMAIN

Loire Valley – Saumur-Champigny + Saumur

Thierry's Domaine, Roches Neuves, whose vineyards are planted in the Saumur (Blanc) and Saumur-Champigny (Rouge) appellations, has rightfully become one of the greatest examples of high achievement in biodynamic vine growing in France. His total dedication to site specific wines produced from Cabernet Franc and Chenin Blanc, his "parcellaires" has produced some of the most exciting wines in the Loire Valley today.

Thierry relocated to the Loire from Bordeaux in the early 1990s, and soon fell under the influence of his spiritual father, Charly Foucault of Clos Rougeard. Thierry harvests on the relatively early side to preserve fresh, vibrant fruit. His goal is to produce Cabernet with purity, finesse, and drinkability, while avoiding rusticity, vegetal character, and hard tannins. When it comes to his Chenin, he makes bone dry, high acid, mineral wines that drink like Chablis young and take on weight slowly over time. His incredibly diverse terroirs are translated with utter clarity and precision.

DOMAINE MÉNARD-GABORIT

Loire Valley - Muscadet

Located on one of the highest points of the Nantes vineyard, the Butte de la Minière at the confluence of both Sèvre and Maine rivers. Their story began in 1734. Since then, five generations have passed, and the sixth has embarked on the adventure in 2019, François and his wife Pauline have joined this lineage of winemakers. Wines are made from Melon de Bourgogne grape variety of the *Muscadet* appellation. Domaine vinifies parcels separately so that each cuvée reflects the terroir. Ménard-Gaborit offer their juices an unusual habitat with oak barrels, ceramic or concrete egg-shaped vats.

KLINGER – Umberto Pilati

Trentino – Dolomiti

Luigi Pilati acquired Maso Clinga, a farmhouse erected in 1500 by the esteemed German Klinger Family. This humble abode nestled above the village of Pressano, beckoning closeness to the shimmering mines whose echoing pickaxes filled the air for centuries. The German term “klingen” meaning to clink or resound, might perhaps lend itself to the name.

Umberto alongside his cherished siblings Enzo and Lorena bear the torch of viniculture as the Klinger Winery. In their possession lie roughly 4 hectares of Nosiola, and 1 hectare of Chardonnay, Pinot Bianco, and Gewurztraminer, 350 to 500 metres above the vast sea. The vines grow on the characteristic Pressano “reddish soil”. A particular ground soil that originated from underlying sedimentary rocks formed about 240 million years ago, with layers of red sandstone, dolomite and limestone.

MUNI DI DANIELE PICCININ

Veneto – San Giovanni Illarione

Daniele is a mountain of a man and a leading light in the natural wine movement in Italy. He has 5 hectares of vines in the hamlet of Muni in the Alpone valley northeast of Verona. His vineyards are between 300 and 500 metres above sea level and feel more alpine than their altitude would suggest.

Daniele has taken it upon himself to champion the local grape Durella – close to becoming extinct and locally known as Rabbiosa meaning *angry* (on account of its typically raging acidity). He has, from the beginning, tried to make wine in the most natural way possible – lots of work (without chemicals in the vineyard) and minimal chemical intervention in the cellar.

VOLCANALIA – Rossella Mastrotto

Veneto – Gambellara

Volcanalia has the honour of owning the most historic vineyards rising on the black lava soil of Gambellara. Work in the vineyard takes place without the use of modern machinery but only manual care due to the steep hills. The only neighbours of the vineyard are roe deer, hares and buzzards peeping out of the nearby woods.

The four hectares of Garganega vines lie harmoniously between the provinces of Verona and Vicenza, in the last layers of the Lessini Mountains at about 300 metres above sea level.

RADIKON

Friuli – Oslavia

Radikon is a 12-hectare estate on the Slovenian border of Italy, and is a truly unique winery. In 1995, Stanko Radikon, the giant in orange and natural wine in the region, decided to reintroduce this long skin contact maceration in his wines and abandoned the use of all chemicals, which at the time was fairly controversial. His reasoning was that, for skin contact wines, where the skins play the fundamental part in the wine, the juice could not be macerated if pesticides were present on the skins. This skin contact advanced as time went on, with many of his cuvées now seeing 30 days on the skins. Stanko passed at 2016 and the winery is now run by his son Saša who worked with his father for the past decade to continue the legacy!

TENUTE MACCHIAROLA – Domenico Mangione

Puglia – Solento

Tenuta Macchiarola sees its origins in the mid-1980s with the purchase of 19 hectares of which 10 were soon planted with vines. After a massive uprooting, in the years when the practice was subsidised, since 2005, it is back to planting vines. Since 2007, the company is led by Domenico Mangione, a pharmacist descended from a family of vineyards. The years to come are years of study, experimentation and passion. It will be a vineyard rented in Lizzano to mark the turn for Domenico. The terrain is a split of Apulian lands surrounded by rock, olive trees and fields sown. Biodynamic farming brings vitality and richness among the rows, with many spontaneous varieties that colour the vineyards. Hence the impetus to a deep respect for nature, being neutral to the vintage and to the will of nature.

CAN SUMOI – Pepe Raventós

Penedès – Montmell

Can Sumoi is the farm for natural wines by Raventós i Blanc. Once they left D.O. Cava in 2012, they decided to find the most suitable place to make this type of wine. In Can Sumoi they found the best location. A 400-hectare farm located at 600 metres of altitude. It is planted with 20 hectares of vineyard since 1645, with native varieties Parellada, Sumoll and Xarello. This last one is in the process of being recovered. The farm also has 3 country houses from the 18th century and an old winery. Here, Pepe Raventós, oenologist and winemaker, wishes to make natural wines with origin, extracting the true reflection of the land where they are born, and its landscapes. To achieve this, he cultivates the entire farm biodynamically. He makes his wines recovering rural traditions, and without adding any kind of oenological additive.

It was back in 2003 that Eduard began to hone his skills as a winemaker when he took on the responsibilities of his family estate. He also worked for the prestigious vineyards of Jane Ventura in Penedes whilst continuing his studies. Much of the winemaking is conducted using porous clay jars, which allow micro-oxidation of the wine and avoid flavours being picked up from barrels. Sicus also uses amphoras, positioned right there on the vineyard, to keep most of the vinification process in the terroir. The taste of the wine differs depending on how it is made, in the cellar or on location.


